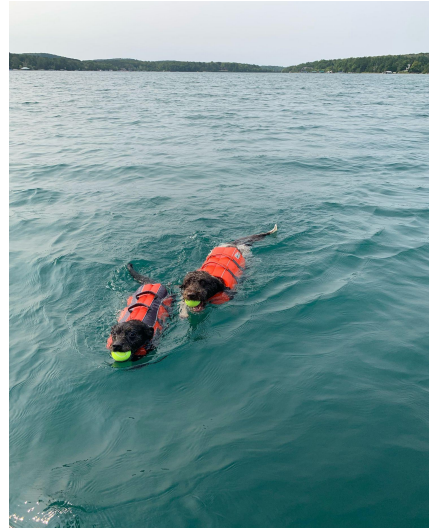
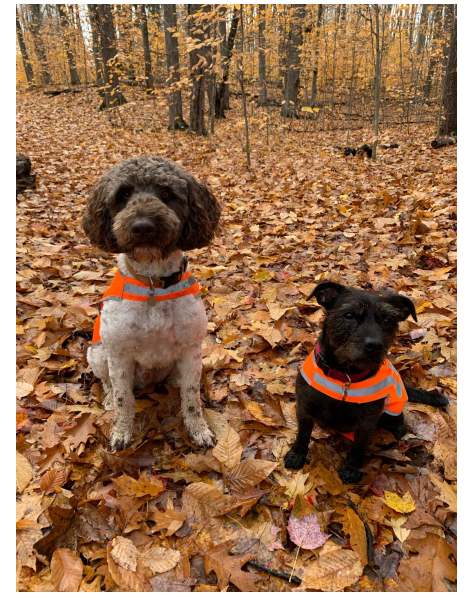

# About Henry

- 🐾 When Henry isn't working at school, he lives with his family, The Frey Family.
- 🐾 At home, Henry is a pet and enjoys playing with his family.

# What is a Therapy Dog?

- When Henry is at school, he is at work. His job is called Therapy Dog.
- A Therapy Dog is trained and certified to provide support and comfort.
- Therapy Dogs are friendly companions that are good listeners. They also help us learn and relax.



# When seeing Henry in the hallway...

- Remember, the hallway is a zero zone.
- We greet Henry with a silent polecat wave and stay in our classline.



# When Henry visits your classroom or the lunchroom...

- 🐾 **Quiet Voices:** We use quiet voices when Henry is near. We stay in our seats and continue our learning or eating. We can greet Henry with a polecat wave.
- 🐾 **Gentle Hands:** If Henry walks by, we use gentle hands to softly pet his back, head or belly, but we quickly return to our work or eating.
- 🐾 **Clean Floor:** Keep Henry safe by making sure the floor is food-free.



# When touching Henry...

- 🐾 When we approach Henry, we greet him slowly and quietly.
- 🐾 We show him the the palm of our hand.
- 🐾 Once he has sniffed, we may gently pet him softly on his back, head, or belly.
- 🐾 Only trained adults are allowed to hold Henry's leash.
